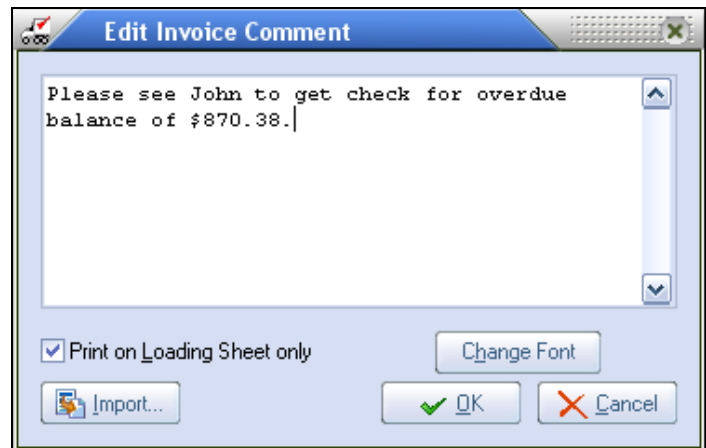

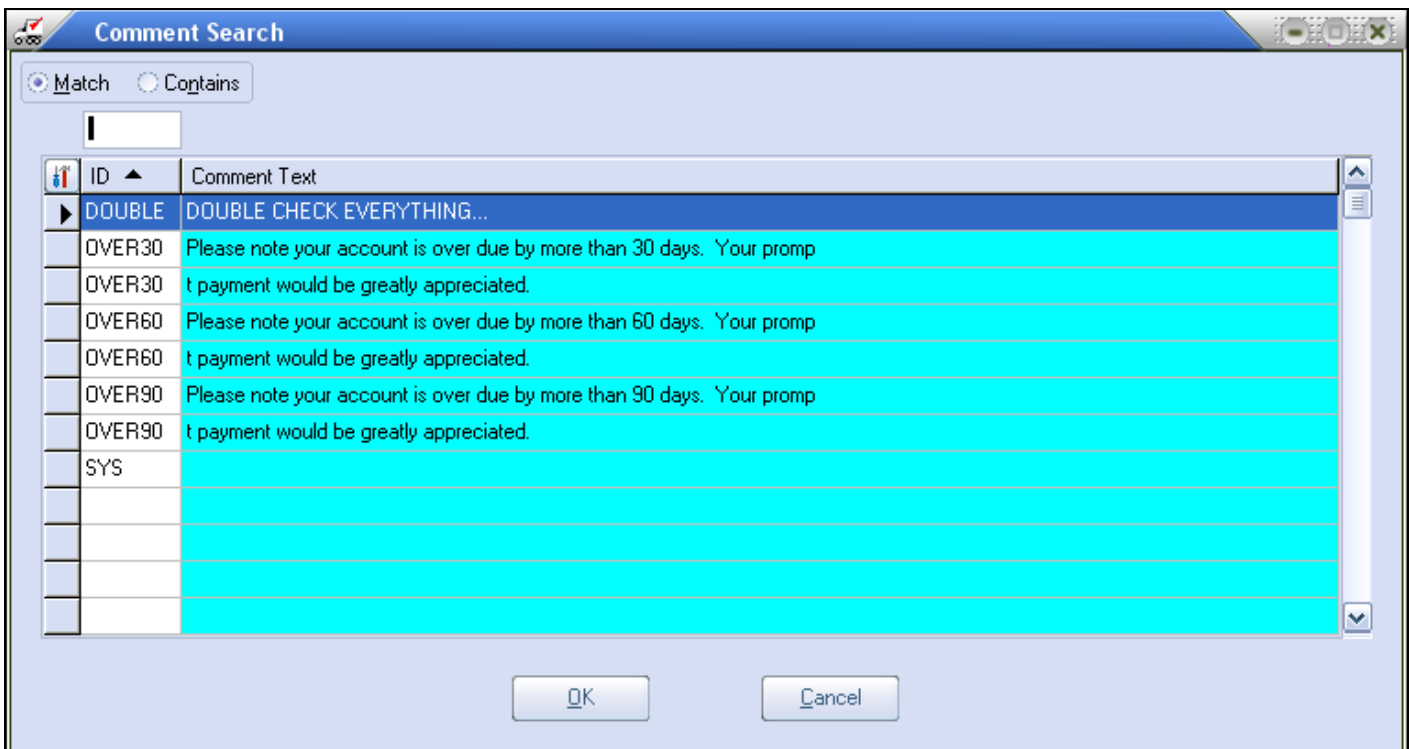
• Edit Comment Option

- Opens the **Edit Invoice Comment** dialog so you can write invoice comments.
- When you click on the **Comment** button, and not the drop down arrow, this action also opens the **Edit Invoice Comment** dialog.



• Load Comment Option

- Opens the **Comment Search** dialog where you can select from all the comments you have pre-defined in Comment File Maintenance. These comments can be quickly added to any invoice as needed.
- Use the Comment File Maintenance feature to maintain a set of ready-to-go comments related to your business requirements.


